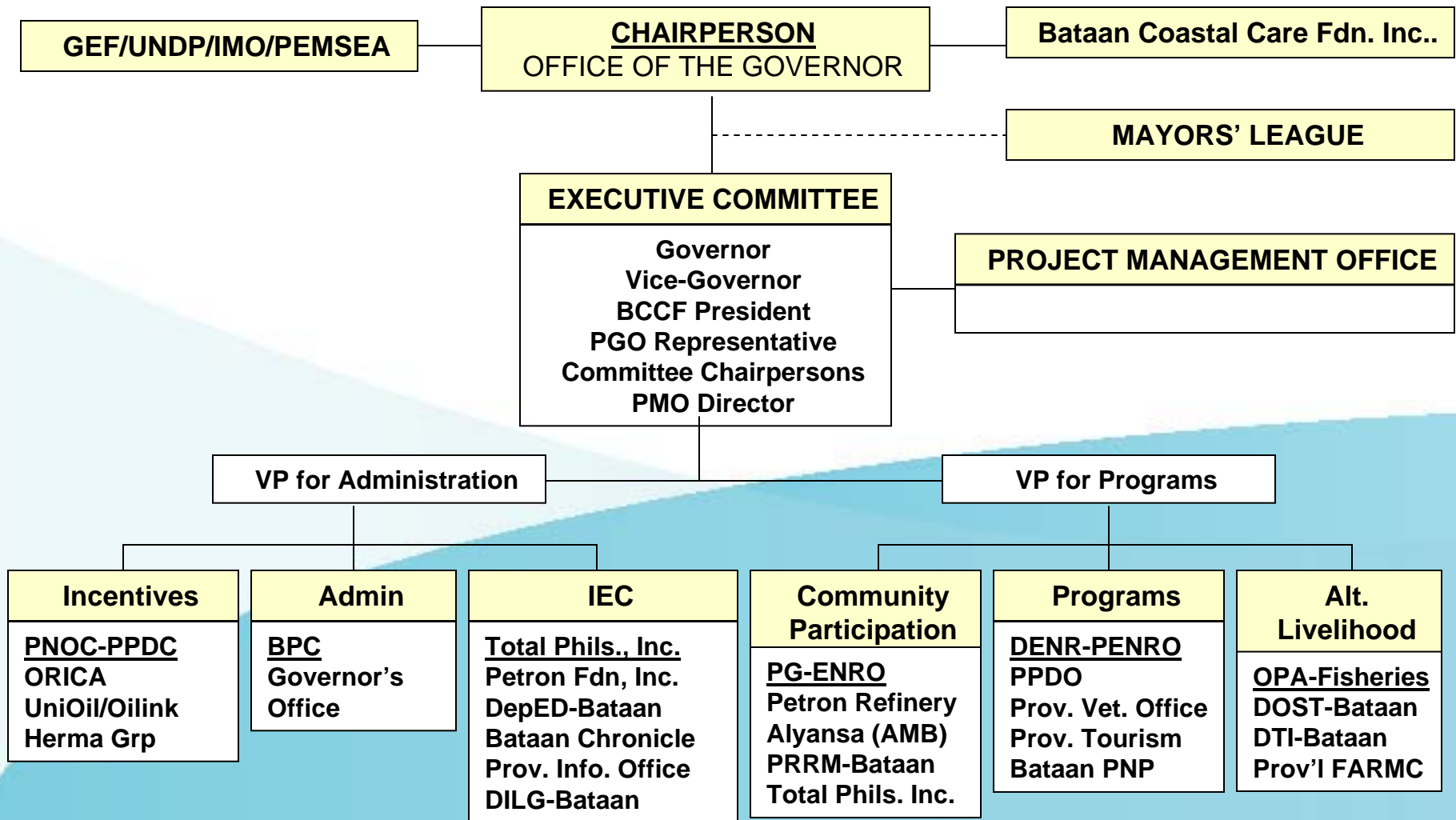

PUBLICATION OF BATAAN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

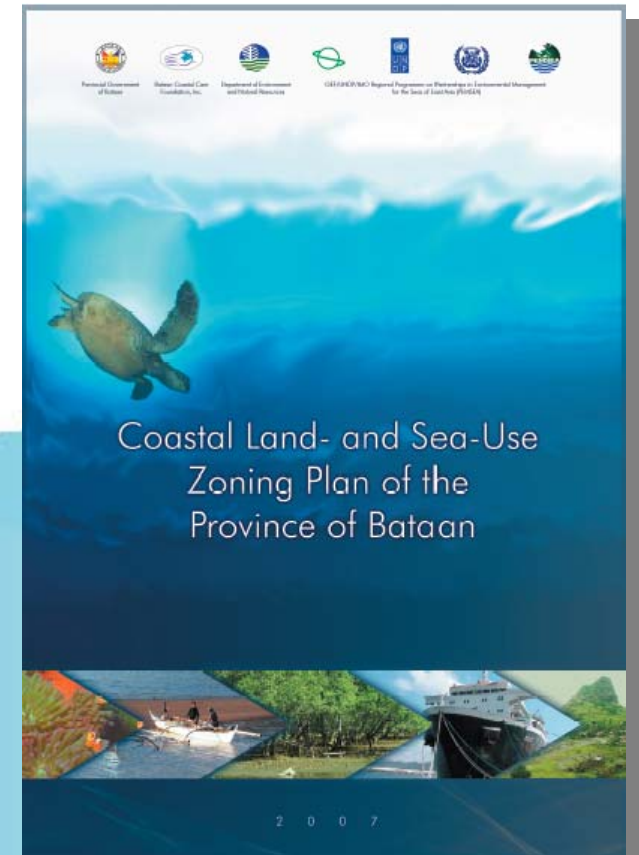
- Adopted by the *Sangguniang Panlalawigan* thru Resolution #68 to serve as the primary framework for integrated coastal management of the province
- Members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) includes the PPDO, PG-ENRO, OPA, Tourism Office, MPDCs, BCCFI and PEMSEA
- Published in December 2006

COMPLETION, PUBLICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COASTAL LAND AND SEA USE ZONING PLAN


- To protect the designated use of coastal zones and reduce adverse environmental impacts of coastal activities;
- Adopted by the Bataan ICM Program – Project Coordinating Committee on October 5, 2006;
- Adopted by the Manila Bay – Project Coordinating Committee on November 13, 2006;
- Adopted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan thru Resolution No. 155 on December 04, 2006.
- Published in 2007

Accomplishments

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COASTAL LAND AND SEA USE ZONING PLAN

- **NAMRIA certified technical descriptions and establishment of municipal water boundaries: City of Balanga, Municipalities of Abucay, Pilar, Orion, Limay, Bagac and Morong**
 - **Drafting of unified zoning ordinance**
 - **Piloting LGU-Abucay in the integration of land- and sea-use zoning plan**

Bataan Integrated Coastal Management Program Accomplishments

ANNUAL ACTIVITIES (Mangrove Planting)

- Since 2004, we have:
 - planted 47,000 seedlings and 337,000 propagules mangroves in a total of 45-hectares within the City of Balanga and Municipalities of Abucay, Pilar, Orion and Limay, Samal, Orani
- With BCCF, LGUs, and PO Sagip Likas Yaman-Dagat ng Bataan or SALBA
- Survival rate of 70%
 - more than 5,000 volunteers from different sectors; volunteers include employees from CitiGroup Philippines

ANNUAL ACTIVITIES (Coastal Cleanup)

No. of Barangays involved	All 87 coastal barangays & 82 (55%) out of 149 inland barangays
No. of Towns / City involved	All 11 municipalities and 1 City
No. of Individual stakeholders involved	Approximately 78,000 individuals
Amount of debris collected	491 metric tons (1999 – 2008)
Length of coastline cleaned	156 kms of 188 kms (83%)
No. of towns regularly doing coastal cleanup	8 towns w/ at least 10 barangays doing coastal clean-up on a weekly / monthly basis

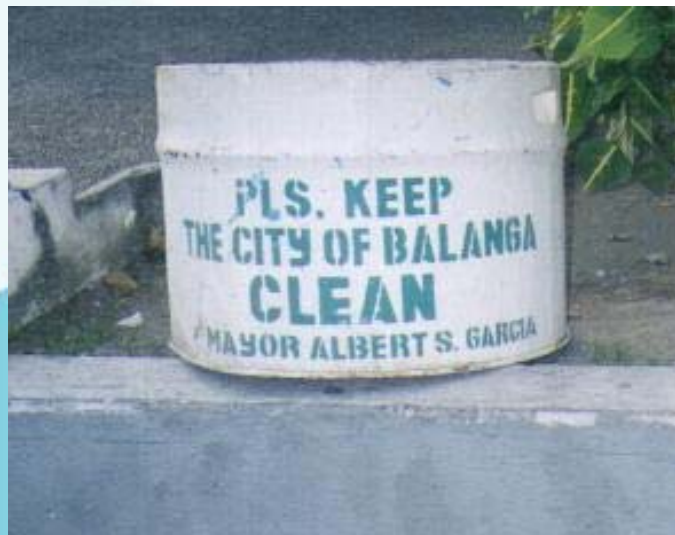
(River Cleanup)

- Balanga City
- Bird count – 15,700 (as of Jan. 2009)
- Species of birds – 30 species

ICM-RELATED ACTIVITIES (Campaign Against Illegal Fishing)

- **Anti-Illegal Fishing and Illegal Logging Task Forces**
- **Patrolling activities**
 - Apprehensions – 216 fishermen
 - Confiscated – 22 fishing vessels, fine-mesh nets, 27 kilos of ammonium nitrate and blasting caps
- **Banning of commercial fishing in Manila Bay**
 - RDC III-RPOC III-RDCC III Joint Resolution No. 03-01-2008 as of August 2008

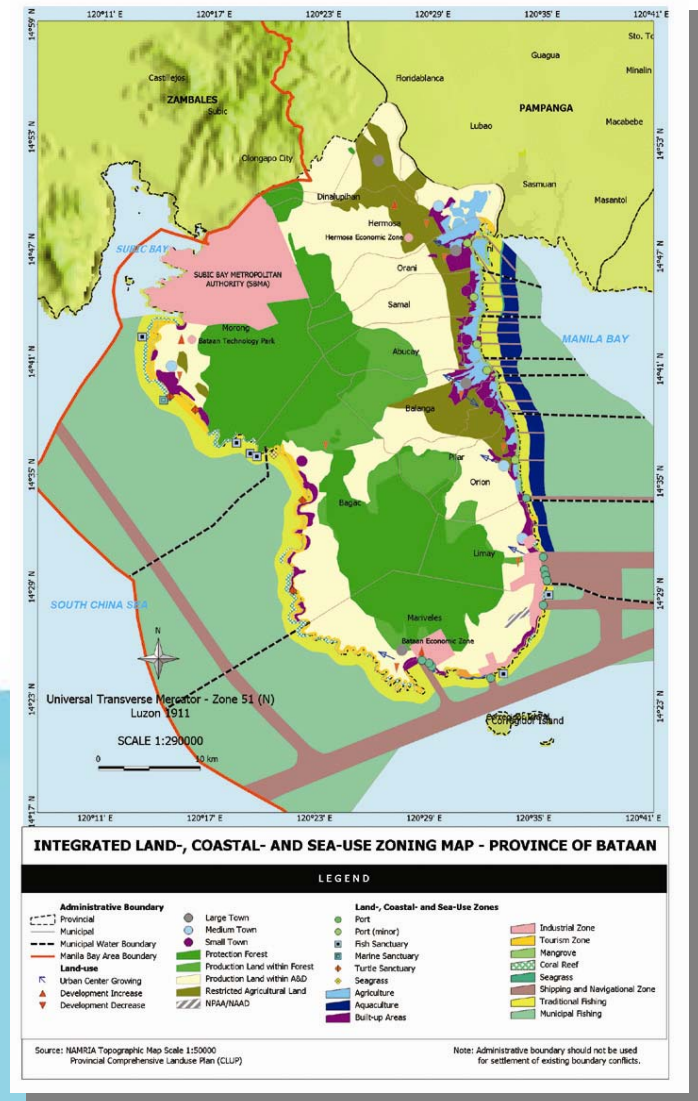
- Site visit of Mr. Aaron Zazueta for the field verification of the GEF Terminal Evaluation done in May 2006

Looking Ahead

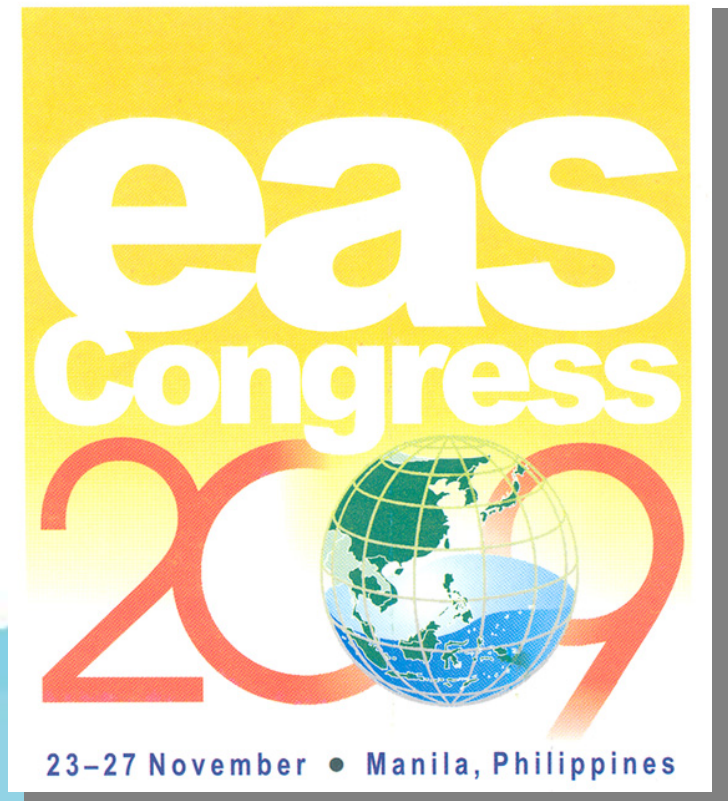
- Continued and full implementation of the Bataan Coastal Land and Sea Use Zoning Plan
